Scriptures from sermon: Ecclesiastes 10-12

- Briefly summarize the main points of the sermon.
- What questions do you still have from today's sermon?
- Read Proverbs 9:10 & James 3:13-17- How does the Bible's definition of wisdom differ from the world's view of it?
- Read Proverbs 11:14 & 1 Timothy 3:1-7- Review Ecclesiastes 10:16-20. What are the consequences of having foolish or immature leaders, either in a nation or other areas of life (e.g., business, church)? How does wise leadership benefit those under its influence?
- Read Matthew 25:14-30- Review Ecclesiastes 11. What does it mean to "cast your bread upon the waters," and how does this passage challenge us to take risks while trusting God with the outcomes?
- Read Psalm 71:17-18- Review Ecclesiastes 12. Why is it essential to live with a sense of accountability to God from an early age?
- What does it mean to fear God and live in obedience to Him in today's world?
- Read Romans 14:10-12- Review Ecclesiastes 12:14. How does the reality of future judgment shape the way we live our lives? How can we reconcile the message of judgment with the grace offered through Jesus?
- After going through the book of Ecclesiastes, what key themes stand out about life, wisdom, and our relationship with God?
- How can the lessons from Ecclesiastes influence how we approach life's uncertainties, struggles, and ultimate purpose?
